

Henna Club

Grades 5-12

Learn about the variety of traditional and modern henna designs, a history of the henna plant, and its role in various societies throughout history! As instructed by Ms. Jenn, students have the opportunity to mix organic henna paste (consisting of dried, ground henna mixed with water, essential oil, and sugar), practice designs on paper, and eventually—with parent permission—adorn their own skin with henna designs.

Students and parents should expect all Henna Club participants to receive reddish-brown henna stains on their skin, either in the form of "henna tattoos" or while otherwise working with the henna paste. Please be aware that while henna is not permanent, it cannot easily be removed from skin and must wear off naturally, usually taking between **1-3 weeks** depending on placement. Henna Club is NOT safe for students allergic to lavender or tea tree oil.
